### The Highest Standards

Utilizing only nationally certified dog and handler teams, the private sector retains this unique and highly effective service to sweep businesses, schools, commercial buildings, seaports and ships, cargo facilities, manufacturing facilities, motor vehicles, and private residences. These highly trained teams can quickly determine if illegal narcotics are, or were, in any given location with the ability to detect less than one gram to large quantities of illegal narcotic substances.

### How Do Drug Detection Dogs Work?

These highly intelligent canines go through intensive training and behavioral programs where they learn to detect several different illegal drugs. Our K-9's are passive alert meaning when the dog alerts to an illegal drug the dog will sit. Our dogs are **not** "aggressive alert", aggressive alert dogs scratch. This same search and detect method is presently utilized by the U.S. Customs Department and law enforcement agencies. Governments and industries worldwide use Drug Detection Dogs for their high rate of efficiency and cost effectiveness. Companies and educational institutions constantly strive to maintain a *drug free environment*, and random inspections as described above have created a strong psychological deterrent to those using or dealing drugs.

### What Happens If Drugs Are Found?

If evidence of illegal activity is uncovered, the next course of action remains your decision.

Options would include: **suspension, termination, drug rehabilitation, parent intervention (for students), or legal prosecution.**

In many cases prosecution does ensue; however, we understand that a client's best interests may not always be served by legal intervention.

**Legal Concerns:** Courts hold to a "public smell" doctrine adopted as an exclusion to the protection of the fourth amendment and analogizes it to the doctrine of plain view which is also outside the purview of the fourth amendment (the doctrine of plain view basically states that contraband exposed to public view is not afforded fourth amendment protection. Under the Court's ruling, the use of canines to detect the presence of drugs or alcohol by sniffing the air around cars, lockers etc., is not a search and therefore there is no fourth amendment concern. The Court additionally found that the fourteenth amendment was not a viable concern. Thus the use of our K-9 search utilizing highly trained detection dogs should not raise any constitutional concerns.
