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On Tuesday November 1, 2005 we will be switching to our winter uniform, Long Sleeve shirts with clip on tie. The winter uniform will be optional through Thursday November 10, 2005. On Friday November 11, 2005 long sleeve shirts with the clip on tie are mandatory.

When wearing the winter uniform (long sleeve shirts) a tie is mandatory, your tie shall be worn with the collar buttoned. Mock turtle neck shirts are not allowed. Shirt sleeves shall be worn down and buttoned, do not roll your sleeves up.

You may wear a tie tack but please get permission if your tie tack is anything other than a small SC State seal, handcuff tie tack or the like.

- Tuesday November 1<sup>st</sup> – Winter uniform, long sleeve with tie optional.
- Friday November 11<sup>th</sup> – Winter uniform mandatory.
